

Prayer and Praise Update  
9 March 2010

We thank God for the wonderful ways He worked in SE Asia. The International Sindhi Partnership Consultation was well attended, over 30 participants from 9 different countries, and a number of decisions were made that we hope will have future impact on reaching more Sindhis for Christ. Those working with Sindhis in one part of the world were encouraged and challenged by Sindhis from other parts of the world. One decision made at the ISPC was to have a prayer summit/walk in Sindh next February 2011.

I met with Sindhis in Manila, Singapore, Kuala Lumpur and Jakarta. In K.L. I even met a Sindhi from Shikarpur, Sindh who had never heard of the Good News of Jesus Christ! It was exciting to see a number of people make decisions for the Lord. One lady was encouraging her husband to accept Christ and he prayed to receive Christ. I assumed that she was a Christian but as we talked further she said she had never accepted Christ but now that her husband had accepted Christ of course she wanted to become a follower of Christ and right there, in a room crowded with people who were not Christians, she prayed to receive Christ. Pray for “Roger and Sunny” to grow in their faith.

Another time, while on a flight from Singapore to Jakarta, I started talking to a business man who had never heard of the need to receive Christ into his life. Before we landed in Jakarta he made a decision for Christ and promised the first person he would tell of his decision would be his wife. Pray for “Willy” to grow and continue to be a faithful witness for Christ. Pray for others who made either first time decisions for Christ or recommitments to Him.

This weekend, Serenity and I fly to a supporting church in Connecticut. The church asked for Serenity to join me so she could address the J.H. and S.H. youth groups to give them a “third culture kid” perspective on missions. Pray that Serenity will be used of God and would be encouraged as she encourages others.
